MADE FOR REAL HOMESCHOOL DAYS

How to Use This Planner

Seven practical tips to get the most out of every page.

1. **Print it your way.** Print at home on US Letter paper at 100% scale (no “fit to page”). Print the whole planner once, then print extra copies of the pages you use most — weekly lesson plans, attendance logs, and grade trackers.
2. **Bind it or binder it.** Three-hole punch and drop it in a binder (easiest to add reprints), take it to an office supply store for an inexpensive spiral bind, or use a discbound system so pages can move around.
3. **It’s undated — reuse it every year.** Nothing here is tied to a calendar year. When a new school year starts, just print fresh copies of the weekly and tracking pages. One purchase, every year of homeschooling.
4. **Color or black-and-white.** The planner looks great in color, but every page prints cleanly in grayscale too, so you can save ink without losing readability.
5. **Start with the goals page.** Before the year begins, fill in the Goals page (page 21) with each child. It keeps the weekly planning honest — every lesson should serve a goal you actually chose.
6. **Keep records where your state wants them.** Many states ask for attendance days, hours, or samples of work. The attendance & hours log (pages 11–12) and grade tracker (pages 13–14) are built for exactly that. File completed pages in your binder as the year goes.
7. **Let the kids own part of it.** Hand older kids the reading log and field-trip log. When they track their own books and trips, the planner stops being paperwork and starts being theirs.
